

# Continuing Professional Development

## ➤ What is CPD:

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) is a means of staying up to date with market activity, changes in legislation and practice, changes in areas of specialization, or simply to study further in fields related to your market or interests.

## ➤ What is a Continuing Professional Development Activity?

CPD activities have been defined as activities rated, verified and approved by Professional Bodies.

### **CPD ACTIVITIES**

The CPD activities will be divided into two:-

#### (i) **Structured activities:**

These will comprise structured activities which the Insurance Institute of Kenya will deliberately organize for the members and a CPD calendar of CPD Events for IIK Members will be shared annually.

#### (ii) **Unstructured activities:**

These will comprise self-development projects by the insurance institute members which they undertake out of their own volition and will include insurance research, attending IIK Events; writing insurance books and published insurance articles.

✚ Insurance Article published	3
✚ Participate in IIK Quiz	2
